Baldrige in Virginia

- 26 Virginia applicants for the Baldrige Award (2005–2020)
- 3 Virginia award applicants in 2016–2020 represent 7,708 jobs, 64 work locations, \$880 million in revenues/budgets, and more than 99,000 customers served.
- 15 Baldrige examiners from Virginia volunteered about \$337,500 in services in 2020.

PricewaterhouseCoopers Public Sector Practice (PSP) was formed in 2005 and is one of 17 business units of PricewaterhouseCoopers. Key customers are the U.S. federal government and state and local governments. Within PwC, this group is the only unit to serve this market. PSP provides business advisory services, including risk consulting, management consulting, and technology consulting. Headquartered in McLean, PSP employs nearly 1,100 people and reported gross revenue of \$265.5 million for fiscal year 2014.

- Decreases in workforce turnover each year from 2009 to 2014, from approximately 22% to 13%, against an industry average of 20%
