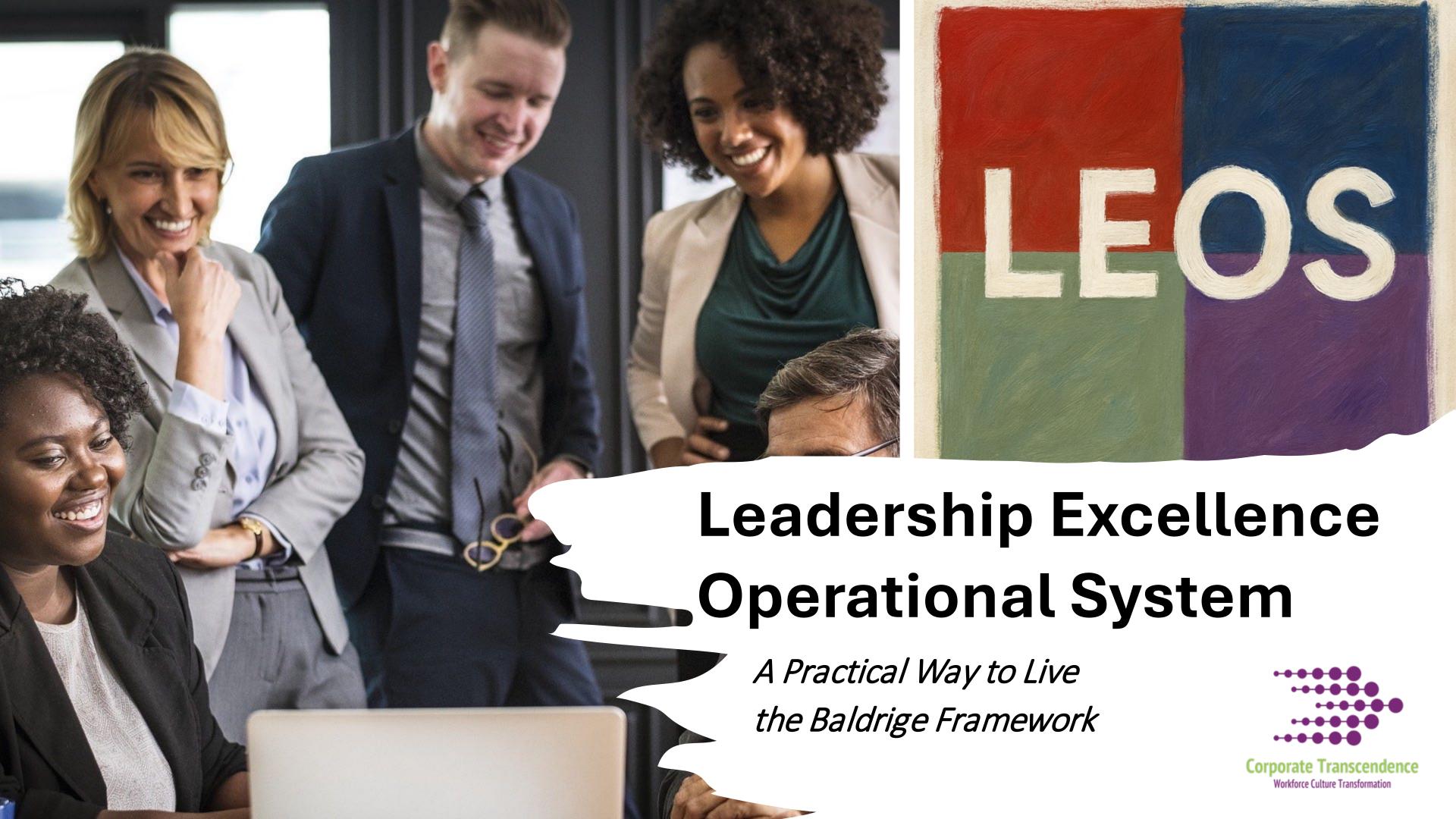

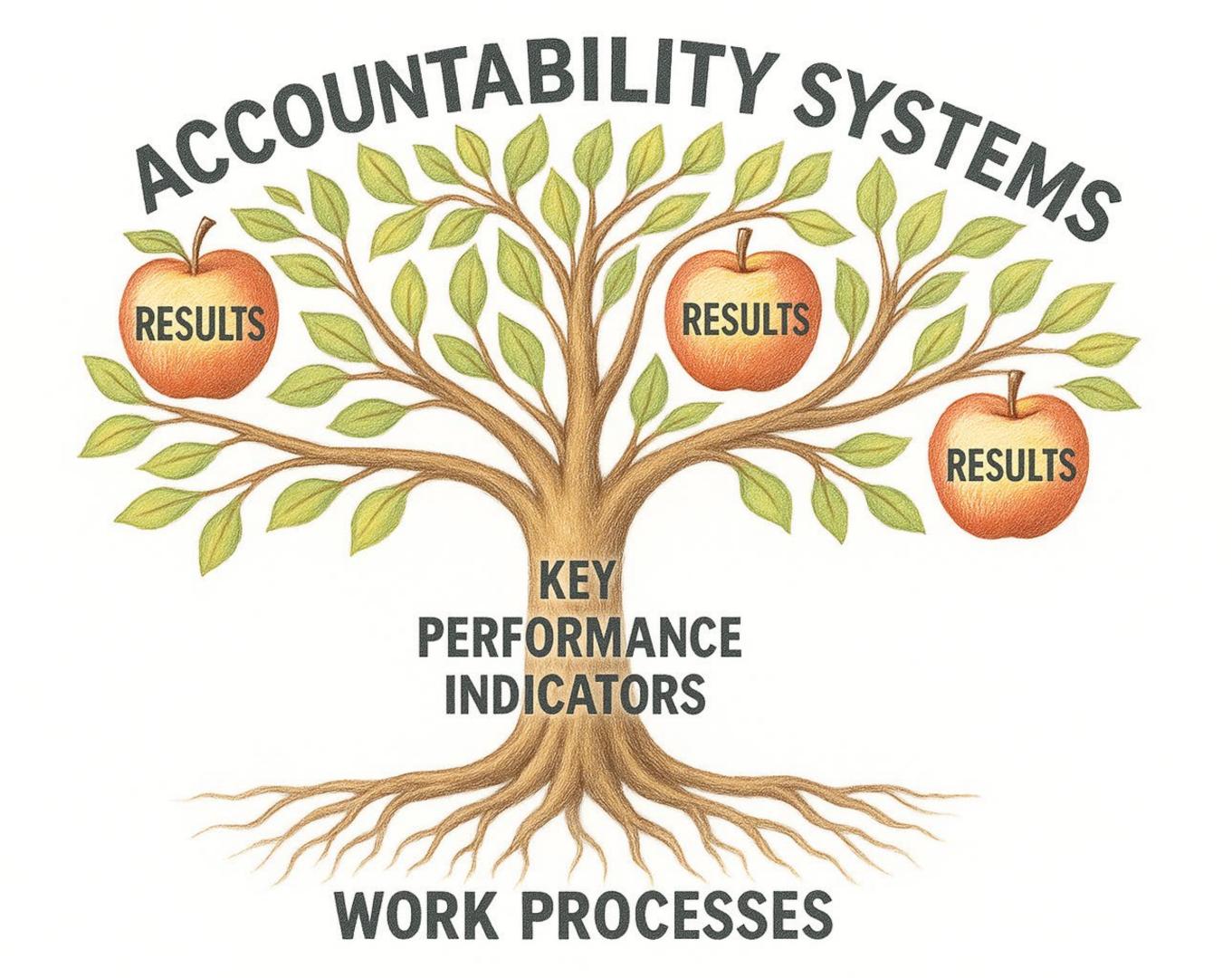

No operating system for leadership

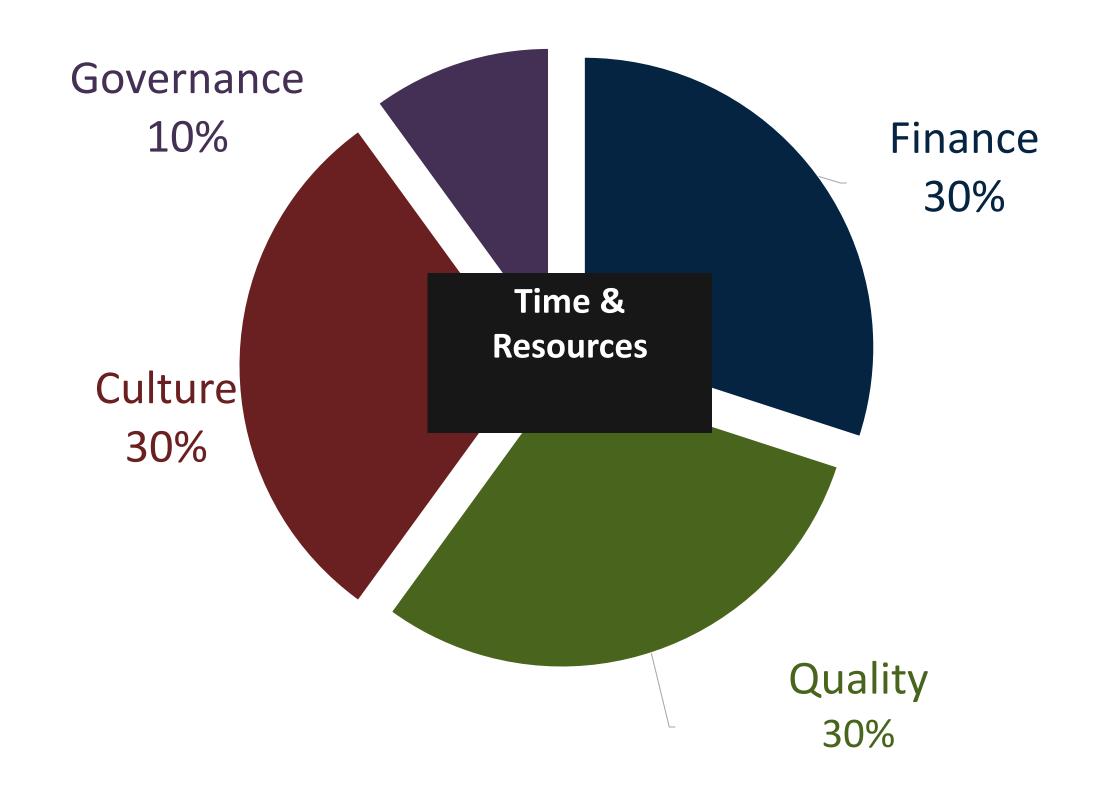
A simple, teachable system that aligns everyone.

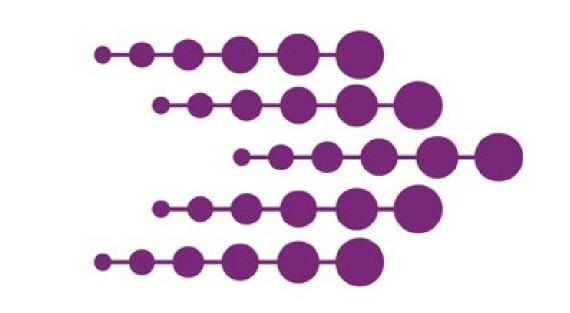
