Baldrige in the U.S.

- U.S. organizations applying for the Baldrige Award have received 1,767 feedback reports detailing organizational strengths and opportunities for improvement.
- 124 Baldrige Award recipients share their role-model practices with other organizations.
- 2010–2020 applicants represent 676,535 U.S. jobs, 5,001 work sites, more than \$189 billion in revenues/budgets, and about 614 million customers served.
- 253 national Baldrige examiners volunteered roughly \$5.7 million in services in 2020.
- In 2019, 29 independently funded and managed regional, state, and sector Baldrigebased programs evaluated 1,598 organizations using 1,686 volunteer examiners.
