In collaboration with the Baldrige community, the Baldrige Program offers a systems approach to organizational excellence, award-winning leadership development, self-assessment tools, organizational assessments by trained experts, workshops on how to improve, and events that showcase best management practices.

- 51 Missouri applicants for the Baldrige Award (2005–2017)
- 2 Missouri award applicants in 2016–2017 represent 2,947 jobs, 30 work locations, more than \$629 million in revenues/budgets, and an estimated 646,000 customers served.
- 7 Baldrige examiners from Missouri volunteered over \$106,000 in services in 2017.

Success Story



Mid-America Transplant Services (MTS) is a private, nonprofit organ procurement organization and eye and tissue bank serving 84 counties in eastern Missouri, southern Illinois, and northeastern Arkansas. MTS works with partner hospitals to procure donated organs and tissues and then provide them to transplant centers and tissue processors.

Highlights

- Decrease from \$7,000 to under \$4,000 over 3 years in cost per donor for in-house cases, compared with approximately \$20,000 in the hospital
- First in the nation in lungs transplanted in 2014, second in 2015; second in kidneys in 2015, seventh for livers in 2015, and top 25% for both hearts and pancreata in 2015
- 80% workforce engagement, at or better than national best-in-class comparisons over 3 years; nearly 90% overall employee retention

Midwest Excellence Institute

The Alliance for Performance Excellence (www.BaldrigeAlliance.org) is a nonprofit national network of Baldrige-based organizations with a mission to grow performance excellence in support of a thriving Baldrige community. Alliance members include Baldrige-based programs that use the Baldrige Excellence Framework to serve organizations from all sectors in their region, state, or a specific industry. These programs annually evaluate and recognize over 1,000 organizations and serve as the feeder system for the national Baldrige Award.

The Midwest Excellence Institute (https://midwestexcellence.org) was established in 1992 to administer the Missouri Quality Award program and to promote quality principles in organizations from all industry sectors. It is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit educational organization funded entirely by memberships and income-generating activities. The Foundation is led by a Board of Directors consisting of key business, education, government, and health care leaders.

GVMH also operates provider and outpatient clinics in Warsaw, Windsor, and Osceola, Missouri. Its mission is "to provide exceptional health and wellness services with friendliness and compassion" to Henry County and the surrounding areas.
