#### **Success Story**

Wellstar Paulding Hospital is a community hospital providing inpatient and outpatient care and emergency services through an acute care hospital and two connected medical office buildings. With a net patient revenue of \$160 million and a workforce of 997 employees (742 clinical, 255 non-clinical/support), 400 physicians, and 105 volunteers, it is located in Hiram.
