In collaboration with the Baldrige community, the Baldrige Program offers a systems approach to organizational excellence, award-winning leadership development, self-assessment tools, organizational assessments by trained experts, workshops on how to improve, and events that showcase best management practices.

- 2 North Carolina award applicants in 2016–2020 represent 11,098 jobs, 9 work locations, more than \$1.5 billion in revenues/budgets, and more than 2.2 million customers served.

Success Story



Iredell-Statesville Schools (I-SS) is a K–12 public school system located in southwestern North Carolina within a diverse community and economy. To meet the needs of its 20,900 students, I-SS offers a variety of educational programs delivered in heterogeneously grouped classrooms, two at-risk/ behavior schools, and virtual curriculum and early college settings. The system also offers before- and after-school programs, short-term alternative site placement programs, and dual enrollment courses in partnership with a local community college. I-SS considers its 3,416 employees "knowledge assets in achieving organizational learning and improvement."

Highlights

- Per-pupil operations expenditures among the lowest in North Carolina
- Ranked academically in the state's top 10 school systems
- 100% of staff positions filled, teacher turnover rate below the state average, and waiting lists for most job openings
- Increase from 64% to 80.7% in cohort graduation rates (the percentage of ninth-grade students who graduate from high school four years later) over 5 years
- Increase in SAT scores from 991 to 1056 over 4 years; increase in state rank from 57th (out of 115 school districts) to 7th over 5 years

Carolina Award for Excellence

The Alliance for Performance Excellence (www.BaldrigeAlliance.org) is a nonprofit national network of Baldrige-based organizations with a mission to grow performance excellence. Alliance members use the Baldrige Excellence Framework to serve organizations from all sectors in their region, state, or industry. These programs annually evaluate and recognize over 1,000 organizations and serve as the feeder system for the national Baldrige Award.

Based on the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award, the North Carolina Award for Excellence (NCAfE; https://www.ies.ncsu.edu/ncafe) is the top state-level recognition presented to an organization that has demonstrated, the highest level of performance excellence by applying the principles of the Baldrige Excellence Framework. NCAfE partners with the Tennessee Center for Performance Excellence to provide examiner training.
