AT THE FIRST SESSION

Begun and held at the City of Washington on Tuesday, the sixth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and eighty-seven

An Act

To amend the Stevenson-Wydler Technology Innovation Act of 1980 to establish the Makolim Baldrige National Quality Award, with the effective of encouraging American business and other corputations to practice effective quality control in the provision of their gools and services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of th United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION L SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the "Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Improvement Act of 1987".

SEC. 2. FINDINGS AND PURPOSES

(a) FINDINGS.—The Congress finds and declares

(i) the mederance of the United States in product and proceed quality has been challenged strongly (and sometimes successfully) by foreign competition, and our Nation's productivity growth has improved less than our competitors over the last two decades;

(2) American business and industry are beginning to understand that yoor quality costs companies as much as 30 percent of sales revenues nationally, and that improved quality of goods and services goes hand in hand with improved productivity, lower costs, and increased profilebility;

(3) strategic planning for quality and quality improvement programs, through a commitment to excellence im manufacturing and services, are becoming more and more ensential to the well-being of our Nation's economy and our ability to compete effectively in the global marketplace;

(6) improved management understanding of the factory fit worker involvement in quality, and greater emphasis on siztical process control can lead to dramatic improvements in cost and quality of manufactured products;

(5) the concept of quality improvement is directly apply to small companies as well as large, to service industries a sa manufacturing, and to the public sector as well as f enterprise;
